



TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Health Requirements:** Participation in karate classes is contingent upon maintaining good health. Only individuals who meet the health standards as prescribed by the club may enroll and continue attending sessions.
- 2. Age Eligibility:** Prospective students must be a minimum of four years of age to enroll in classes. This requirement is in adherence to our insurance terms and conditions.
- 3. Minor Consent:** Individuals under the age of 18 must secure consent from a parent or legal guardian to participate in training sessions. Consent signifies agreement with all club rules and regulations.
- 4. Conduct and Safety:** While instructors will make every effort to provide training in accordance with best practices, students are expected to reciprocate by acting with consideration toward their peers. Aggressive or uncontrolled violent behavior is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action.
- 5. Class Schedule and Payments:** Please note that classes will not be held during the February, April, and Christmas half-terms. Monthly fees are standardized and do not fluctuate with the number of sessions offered per month. The fee covers a minimum of eight classes, with additional sessions scheduled as necessary to fulfill this quota.
- 6. Supervision and Personal Belongings:** The club's responsibility for minors is limited to the confines of the dojo. Personal items left in the dojo after training are not the responsibility of Eagle Karate Club.
- 7. Access to Additional Training:** Enrollment entitles students to participate in other training sessions across different club sections, subject to the discretion and approval of the respective instructors.
- 8. Refunds and Absences:** The club will not issue refunds for brief absences. However, in the event of prolonged illness or injury spanning beyond three weeks, parents or guardians are encouraged to discuss potential accommodations with the instructor.
- 9. Examination Policy:** While examinations are optional and held bi-monthly, participants opting to take the exam must provide the examination fee and present their Budopass on the examination day. Failure to provide these will necessitate postponement to the subsequent examination date.
- 10. Equipment Requirement:** Upon the instructor's recommendation, it is obligatory for parents to procure the appropriate protective gear for their child's safety during training.
- 11. Fee Submission:** Fees should be submitted promptly as specified by the club. Delayed payments may result in suspension of the participant's enrollment and access to training sessions.
